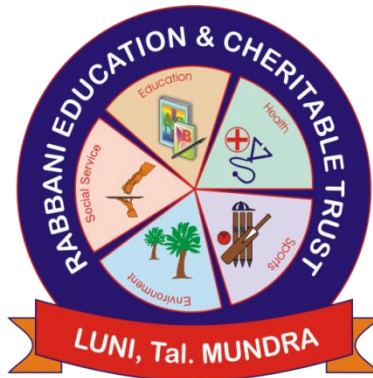

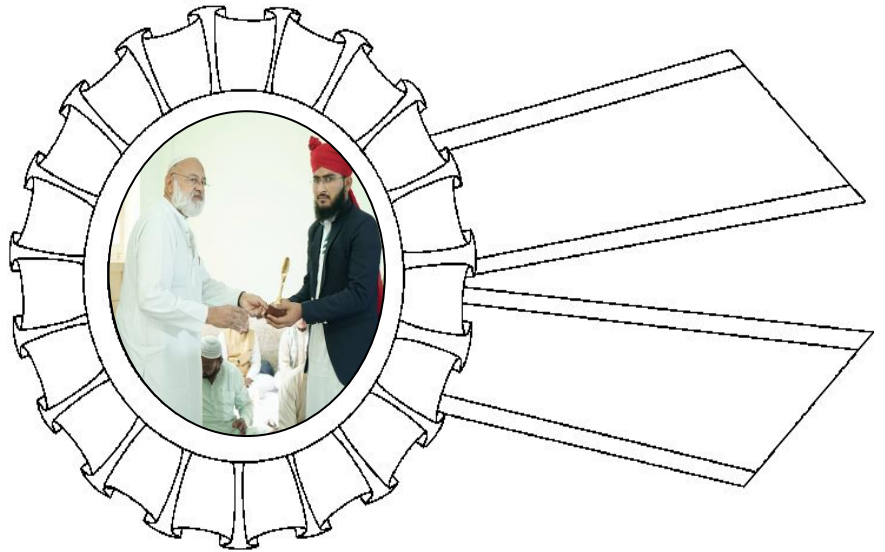
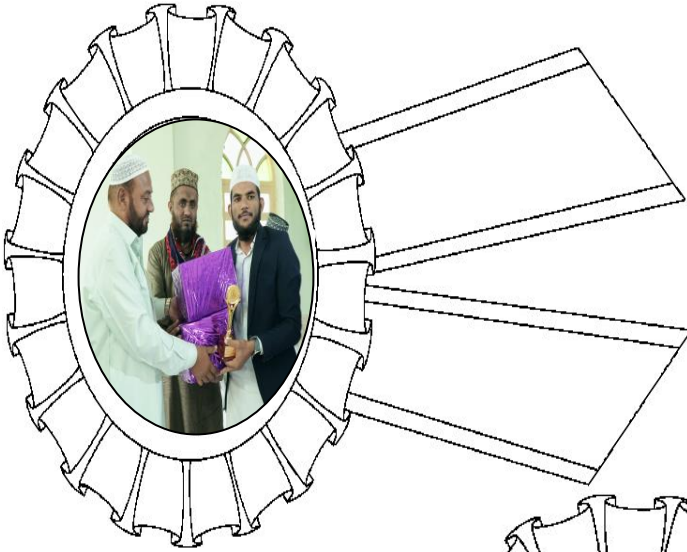

S.M.J Primary School



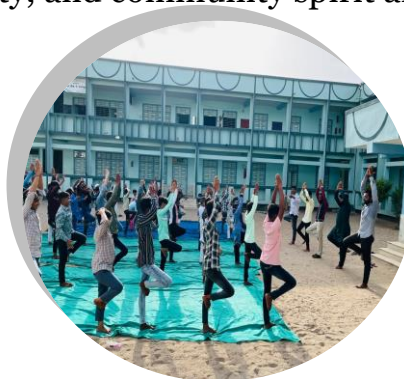
Our school is committed not only to academic excellence but also to the holistic development of every child. We believe that true education extends beyond textbooks and classrooms, shaping students into confident, responsible, and value-driven individuals. With this vision, we focus on enhancing the mental, physical, emotional, and social abilities of all learners.

We emphasize strong moral values, discipline, positive behaviour, confidence building, and overall personality development. To nurture these qualities, the school conducts a variety of activities, including daily morning assemblies, value-education sessions, leadership and personality development programs, as well as diverse extracurricular and cultural events. Each activity plays a meaningful role in developing well-rounded young individuals.

At present, the school has 135 students, all actively participating in academic learning along with co-curricular activities.

Supporting national initiatives, the school strongly aligns with the Government of India's Beti Bachao, Beti Padhao (BBBP) mission, which works towards eliminating gender discrimination and empowering girls. Inspired by the vision of "Save the Girl Child, Educate the Girl Child," we have undertaken several steps to promote and strengthen girls' education within the community.

Every year, the school proudly celebrates important events such as Sports Day, Independence Day, Republic Day, Children's Day, and various cultural programs that foster teamwork, patriotism, creativity, and community spirit among students.





In 2013, the school expanded its vision by introducing upper-primary classes from Grades 6 to 8, ensuring that children receive a strong academic foundation before entering secondary education. To enrich the linguistic abilities of girls, the school offers specialized vernacular classes in Arabic, Urdu, and Farsi. Students belonging to economically weaker families are provided with essential learning materials, stationery, and other academic support.

Additionally, financial assistance such as fee waivers and scholarships is extended to children who are poor or orphaned. For orphan students, the school goes a step further by connecting them with compassionate families willing to offer them a stable and caring home environment.

Over the past decade, the school has transformed from a small educational initiative into a vibrant learning community. What began as an expansion into upper-primary education has grown into a holistic ecosystem where academic excellence, cultural development, value education, and child welfare are deeply integrated. The school has consistently strengthened support systems for underprivileged children, introduced language-skill programs for girls, and expanded co-curricular engagement. With each passing year, the student strength, community participation, and overall impact have grown steadily—reflecting a decade of dedication, progress, and meaningful change in shaping young futures.

Our school is equipped with a well-maintained science laboratory that encourages hands-on learning and experimentation. The library provides a rich collection of books and resources to support reading habits and academic growth. A modern computer lab enables students to develop digital skills essential for today's technology-driven world. The school also has a spacious sports ground that promotes physical fitness, teamwork, and regular sports activities. Together, these facilities create an enriching environment that supports holistic development. They ensure that students receive a balanced education beyond classroom learning.

The school organized a prize distribution ceremony to honour its high-achieving students. Trophies, certificates and scholarships were presented by the principal and chief guests. Students were applauded for academics, sports and cultural activities. The event celebrated effort and inspired all pupils to aim higher in the coming year excellence in.



Program Brief



The Welfare and Prize Distribution Program aims to motivate students, encourage academic excellence, and support the holistic development of children in the school. Under this initiative, Rabbani Education & Charitable Trust provides essential welfare materials—such as stationery, school supplies, uniforms, and learning aids—to students from economically weaker families. The program also includes a formal prize distribution

ceremony where outstanding performers in academics, discipline, leadership, and extracurricular activities are recognized. This initiative promotes equal learning opportunities, boosts student morale, and fosters a culture of appreciation and achievement within the school.

Program Brief

The Sports Tournament organized by Rabbani Education & Charitable Trust aims to promote physical fitness, teamwork, and sportsmanship among children and youth. The event brings together students from various backgrounds to participate in a range of sporting activities such as football, cricket, athletics, and indoor games.

Through this tournament, the Trust provides a platform for young talents to showcase their abilities while learning important life skills like discipline, cooperation, and leadership. The program supports holistic child development and encourages youth involvement in positive, healthy recreation.

Program Outcomes

Program Brief

Rabbani Education & Charitable Trust organized a Vocational Training & Entrepreneurship Development Program in Mundra, Kutch, aimed at enhancing the livelihood opportunities of local youth and women. The program focused on building practical vocational skills, nurturing entrepreneurial abilities, and creating awareness about various income-generating avenues. Through structured training sessions, hands-on demonstrations, and mentorship support, participants were empowered to start small-scale enterprises and improve their economic stability. The initiative emphasized self-reliance, capacity building, and long-term community development.

Outcome of the Program

- Enhanced Skill Development: Participants acquired job-ready vocational skills relevant to local market needs.
- Entrepreneurial Mindset Created: Many trainees gained confidence to start micro-enterprises and explore self-employment opportunities.
- Increased Income Opportunities: Several beneficiaries began applying their newly learned skills in local markets, improving household income.
- Women Empowerment: A significant number of women reported increased confidence, mobility, and decision-making power within their families.
- Community Impact: The program contributed to strengthening the local livelihood ecosystem and building a foundation for sustainable economic growth in Mundra, Kutch.



Program Brief: Empowering Communities Through Fisheries-Based Livelihoods

The fisheries livelihood program in Luni Village is designed to strengthen the economic resilience of rural households by promoting sustainable fish farming practices. The initiative focuses on capacity building, providing technical training, quality inputs, and ongoing handholding support to beneficiaries. Through improved pond management, scientific fish rearing techniques, and market linkage support, the program empowers community members—especially women and marginalized families—to develop fisheries as a reliable income-generating activity. The program aims to enhance food security, boost household income, and create local employment opportunities within the village.

Program Outcomes

- Increased income generation for participating households through improved fish production.
- Adoption of scientific fish farming techniques leading to higher yield and reduced production losses.
- Enhanced skills and confidence among beneficiaries, making them self-reliant in managing fisheries operations.
- Strengthened local market linkages enabling better price realization for harvested fish.
- Improved nutritional access for families through availability of locally produced fish.
- Community-level empowerment as fisheries becomes a sustainable and scalable livelihood option in Luni Village.





Rabbani Education & Charitable Trust implemented a Public Health Interventions & Medical Outreach Program aimed at improving access to essential healthcare services for underserved communities. The initiative focused on preventive health awareness, early disease detection, and providing primary medical support through health camps, screenings, and counselling sessions. Special emphasis was placed on maternal and child health, hygiene practices, nutrition, and lifestyle-related

diseases. The program connected beneficiaries to required medical services and promoted healthier behaviours within the community.

Outcome of the Program

- **Improved Healthcare Access:** Hundreds of beneficiaries received free check-ups, basic treatment, and medical advice closer to their homes.
- **Early Diagnosis:** Screenings helped identify cases of anaemia, hypertension, diabetes, and other common illnesses at an early stage.
- **Increased Health Awareness:** Participants gained knowledge about hygiene, sanitation, nutrition, and disease prevention.
- **Maternal & Child Health Support:** Women benefited from counselling on prenatal care, immunization, and infant nutrition.
- **Behavioural Change:** Communities adopted healthier practices, contributing to reduced illness burden.
- **Strengthened Community Health Systems:** Referrals were made to government health centres, improving linkage to long-term care.

FREE HEALTH CAMP



Animal Welfare Activities Program Brief



Rabbani Education & Charitable Trust carried out a series of Animal Welfare Activities to promote compassion, safety, and better living conditions for stray and domestic animals in the community. The initiative focused on providing medical care, vaccinations, rescue support, and awareness on responsible animal care. Activities included animal health camps, emergency treatment, sterilization

awareness, and community sensitization drives to reduce animal suffering and improve coexistence between humans and animals.

Outcome of the Program

- Improved Animal Health: Many stray and domestic animals received veterinary care, vaccinations, and basic treatment for injuries and infections.
- Reduced Animal Suffering: Timely rescue interventions and first aid helped prevent avoidable deaths and prolonged suffering.
- Community Awareness: Residents became more informed about responsible pet care, adoption, and the importance of sterilization.
- Strengthened Human–Animal Harmony: Awareness efforts encouraged compassionate behaviour, reducing instances of neglect and cruelty.
- Support to Local Ecosystem: Healthier animals contributed to a cleaner and safer community environment.



Plantation Drive



The Plantation Drive aims to promote environmental sustainability and create greener community spaces through active participation of students, teachers, and local residents. The initiative encourages awareness about the importance of trees in combating climate change, reducing pollution, and improving overall ecological balance. During the drive, saplings of various species—such as fruit-bearing, medicinal, and shade-giving trees—are planted in school premises, public areas,

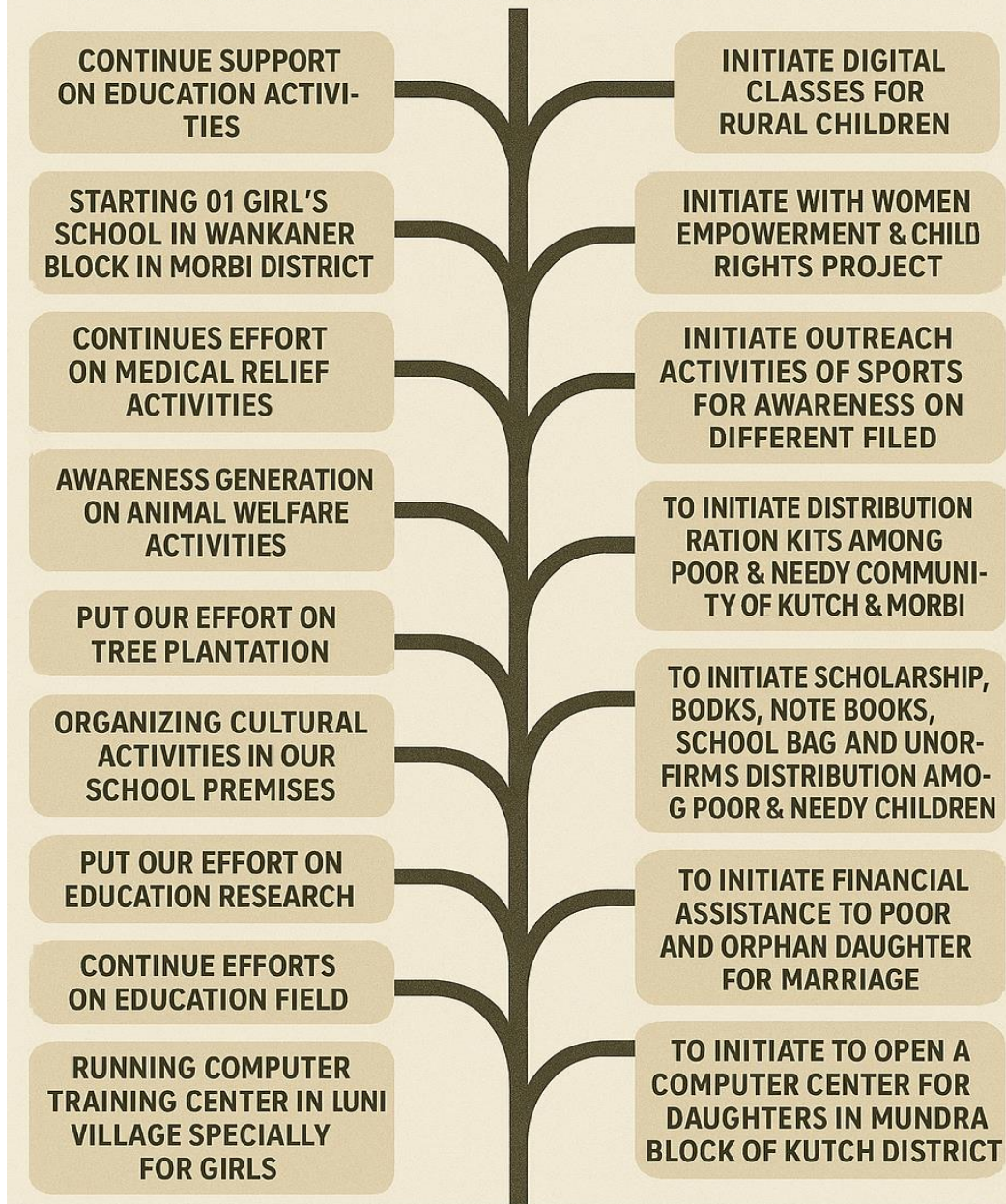

Program Outcomes

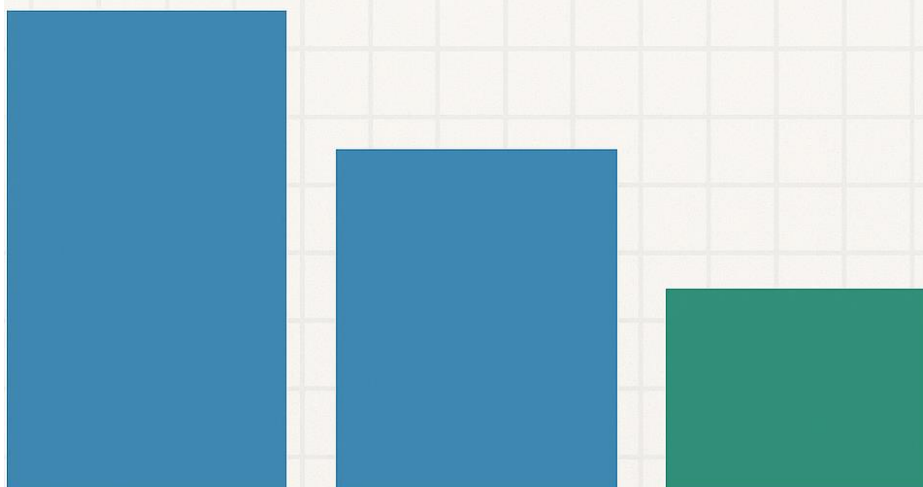
